Sterling Announces Two Large Transportation Solutions Project Awards

THE WOODLANDS, TX – February 25, 2025 – Sterling Infrastructure, Inc. (NasdaqGS: STRL) ("Sterling" or "the Company") today announced that Sterling's Ralph L. Wadsworth (RLW) subsidiary has been awarded two significant transportation projects:

- The I-15 1800 North Interchange project for the Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) will enhance regional mobility in Davis County, Utah. The project has a total value of \$195 million and is expected to begin in spring 2025 and continue through late 2027. RLW has a 60% interest in the job, while joint venture partner Whitaker Construction holds the remaining 40%. The project will be included in first quarter 2025 backlog.
- The I-25 North Corridor project is part of the Colorado Department of Transportation's (CDOT) northern transportation improvement project. The award has a total value of \$86 million and marks the next phase of a multi-year project that began pre-construction activities in 2018. RLW's share of this phase is 51%, with joint venture partner SEMA Construction at 49%. The award is included in December 31, 2024 combined backlog.

CEO Remarks

"These awards exemplify the attractive project opportunities we are seeing in our core Rocky Mountain and Arizona regions," stated Joe Cutillo, Sterling's CEO. "RLW continues to prove that its technical capabilities and best-in-class execution make it a trusted partner for highway and bridge work," Mr. Cutillo concluded.
